

Dear Land Trust Member,

We partner with CartoTracks, a local mapping company, to provide a unique member benefit: an interactive electronic map app to help you navigate 70+ miles of Land Trust trails. The map app - free with your annual Land Trust membership - may be accessed via your electronic devices. You can also share points of interest with friends and track your hiking, running, or biking progress.

## Just follow these steps to access Land Trust maps:

- 1. The app that drives these maps is free and available for both Android and iOS devices. Search the appropriate app store for "Avenza Maps" and download.
- 2. Visit CartoTracks.com on your mobile device. Click "My Account" then select "Create an Account"
- 3. Complete the "Create Account" form, using your email address (associated with your Land Trust membership). Click "Create Account" at the bottom when finished. A green bar will appear along the bottom if completed successfully and you will receive a confirmation email shortly. (Check your spam folder if you don't see an email from support@cartotracks.com soon.)
- 4. Open the confirmation email and click "Verify Your Email". This should open CartoTracks.com in a browser and indicate that your account has been activated.
- 5. Click "Login" and log in using your email and password.
- 6. To access Land Trust maps, select the Menu button then click "My Account" --> "My Subscriptions" --> "View Bundle Maps". For any map that you wish to download, simply click "Download into Avenza Maps App" and the download should begin shortly.





## **Managing Your Maps**

The Avenza Maps app will store a maximum of three maps at one time. Please keep this in mind when loading your Land Trust maps and plan accordingly. Load only the maps that you need at a given time. Your maps are linked through your CartoTracks account so they can be easily downloaded at a later time. There is an option to add more than three maps with an in-app subscription of \$29.99/year. To activiate this subscription, start a download of a fourth map. A pop-up will appear in the app. Select "Need less? Unlock map import limit >>." Otherwise, simply delete a map and add another in it's place as you reach the three map limit. Remember to export any map features that you've added before you delete a map.

## **Navigating Using Your Maps**

Locate yourself on a map using the arrowhead symbol in bottom left for iOS devices or the crosshairs symbol at top left in Android while on the property. You can find additional information and tips for operating the app at avenzamaps.com.
